10 TIPS FOR YOUR PITCH

- -X- Judges are looking for original ideas.
- Clearly state what your idea is.
- Remember your idea needs to be claims focused.
- What are the practical implications positive and negative of your idea?
- What problem is it solving? What improvement is it making? Why is the idea needed?
- For video entries it is not the quality of the recording, but the content that matters.

- -ii- For written submissions, stick to the word limit.
- Hit the criteria! Submissions are judged on four specific criteria with different weightings (listed below).
- independent perspective.
- Think creatively look for research which may be relevant from Australia, overseas markets, or possibly even undertake your own research

HOW TO ENTER

You can enter as an individual or as a team (of up to 3 people) by presenting your idea or opinion in your choice of either:

- A short video (no longer than 5 minutes), or
- A written submission (min 600 words up to 1,500 words max), or
- A voiceover of images in PowerPoint.

JUDGING CRITERIA

10%

- 1. How well you set out the basic premise of your idea or 40% your view.
- 2. The reasons you outline for why it's a good idea or a 30% persuasive view.
- 3. Consideration of the outcomes and wider 20% implications (positive and negative) that your idea or view might have if adopted.
- 4. The quality and creativity of your entry.
